

Homework will be set regularly in Year three and four following the school policy. It is an important part of the children's learning and follows on from work completed in class giving parents and carers the opportunity to work alongside their children. It also allows those at home to have a better idea of the areas being studied week by week.

Each year group will set homework and collect it in for marking. The expectation for homework is set out below.

#### **Year 4**

Reading every day for 10-20mins progressively increasing through the year.

Spelling once a week to learn and an activity to complete based on Literacy work.

Maths once a week activity linked to learning and times tables.

In addition to this we plan to send three family projects linked to curriculum topics through the year. These will be activities which will involve research or making something that can be completed together with support. A longer period of time will be allocated for these projects to be completed.

We do expect ALL children to complete the homework set. If your child does not understand what the task is they need to talk to the teacher and ask for help. We are always happy to help children that are finding it a little difficult.
