

Year 5 and 6 Spellings

The National Curriculum specifies 100 words that all children in Years 5 and 6 should be taught. This is in addition to specific spelling rules which are outlined below.

We have split the 100 words into two sets, the first for Year 5 and then Year 6. The children are given these words to learn throughout the year in batches of 12 or so at a time.
