Manage distractions

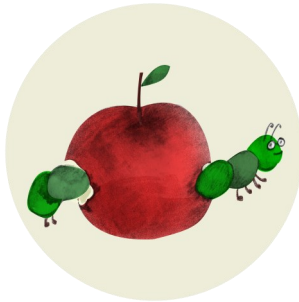
Get lost in the task
