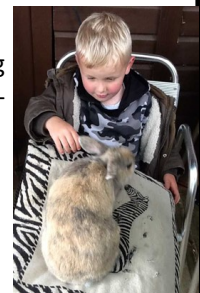
Kingswood Residential—Year 3/4
