Topic	The Land before time	
<b>English</b>	<p>Reading</p> <p>Try to select a Dinosaur book to read. It could be fiction or non-fiction. Send a video into dojo about your book and if you would recommend it to others.</p>	<p>Choose a dinosaur, for example a Tyrannosaurus Rex. How many words can you find within it? e.g. ran, roar, sunny.</p> 
<b>Maths</b>	<p>Choose a number between 0 and 12. Multiply it by 2, 5 and 10. E.g. My number is 6... <math>6 \times 2 = 12</math> <math>6 \times 5 = 30</math> <math>6 \times 10 = 60</math> Can you repeat by choosing a different number?</p>	<p>A Tyrannosaurus Rex' footprint was about 1 metre long. Draw around and measure your feet and your family's feet. Compare the sizes and try to work out how much smaller they are than a T-Rex' foot.</p>  <p style="text-align: right;"><b>Challenge</b></p>
<b>Science and the outside environment</b>	<p>Plant a seed and keep a seed diary of how it grows over the half term. What changes do you notice? Where is the best place to grow it? How does the seed change over time?</p> 	<p>Play 'Dinosaur Discovery' to collect all the dinosaur stickers and become a dino-expert! While you are playing this game you will be 'working scientifically' – that means thinking like a scientist! <b>Humanities</b>	<p><b>Challenge</b></p> <p>Create a fact file about a dinosaur of your choice. Include interesting facts and all the features that you have learnt about information texts.</p> 	<p>Create a timeline of events you know about e.g. when you were born, when you parents were born, The great fire of London.</p> <p>Where would you place when the dinosaurs roamed the earth on your timeline?</p>
<b>Creative Arts</b>	 <p>Draw a scene from the Jurassic Period. What was the landscape like? Include dinosaurs that lived during this period.</p>	<p><b>COMPETITION HOMEWORK</b></p> <p>Design and make your own 3D dinosaur using any materials of your choice. Upload photos to dojo and a winning entry will be chosen before the Easter holidays.</p> 

Each week choose one item from the grid. For the time being, **UPLOAD** your homework to Class dojo by 12pm Thursday each week (do not bring sheets of paper into school with homework).

Remember that part of your home learning is also to read at home at least three times a week. This needs to be recorded in your yellow reading diary and signed by an adult in order to move up the Reading Rainbow. Like homework, upload a photo of your reading diary comments to dojo and we will tick off your reads each week.
