Key Knowledge & Skills	
Nursery and Reception	Children will have a variety of opportunities to develop their imagination and creativity by experimenting and playing with a wide range of media and materials. By looking and at the work of a range of artists and process children will develop an understanding of art and artists.
Early Learning Goal.	By the end of Reception children will be able to safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, colour mixing, design, texture, form and function. The children will have regular opportunities to engage with the arts, enabling them to explore and play with a wide range of media and materials. They will have opportunities to share their creations, explaining the process they have used. They will begin to show accuracy, complexity and care when drawing- creating closed shapes with continuous lines and begin to use these shapes to represent objects. They will be able to show different emotions and movement or noise in their drawing.
